

2007 Animelowa Artist Alley Guidelines

Submission Guidelines

- Animelowa is a convention for all fans of anime; please insure that all artwork is appropriate for the nature of the convention.
- The Artists Alley is intended as a place for fans to meet artists, purchase prints, and commission works.
- Please keep Animelowa's family-friendly atmosphere in mind when choosing works to display on your table. Mature works are not prohibited, but please use good judgement in displaying them.
- Sale of copied licensed artwork is prohibited at this years Animelowa.
- You the Artist is responsible to obtain permission for selling any fanart of licensed characters. Animelowa will not obtain permission for you.
- Commissions and homemade items (such as hats and jewelry) fall under the category of parody art and **will** be allowed for sale at Animelowa.
- Fanart depicting licensed characters in the artists own style, pose, and/or setting will be allowed to be sold.
- Of course Animelowa's Artists Alley encourages Artists to bring, display and sell original art that is of the artists own creation.

Reservation Guidelines

- The Artists Alley Reservation Form must be completed, signed and sent with full payment to:

- Your reservation must be received by **July 20, 2007**.
- You are fully responsible for all materials which you display. Animelowa is not responsible for lost or stolen artwork. Please use good judgement and never leave your table unattended.
- Schedule for setup and teardown of the Dealers Room and Artists Alley will be provided later on the Animelowa website.
- Since the Artists Alley is staffed and run by volunteers, in all matters, the decision of the Artists Alley Department Head are final. The exhibitor agrees to protect, keep, and save Animelowa forever harmless from any damage(s) or charge(s) imposed for violations of any law or ordinance by any exhibitor, their employees or agents, as well for failure to comply with the terms and agreements. The exhibitor shall at all times protect, indemnify, save, and keep harmless Animelowa against and from any loss, cost, damage, liability, or expense which arises out of or by reason of any act or omission of exhibitor, his employees, or agents.

Fees and Payments

Prices are paid once and last the entire weekend. All checks and money orders are to be made to **Animelowa**.

- A table can be reserved for \$50.00. This is a 6' table, covered and skirted.
- Half tables maybe made available if the need arises.
- Electricity is available for an additional charge \$40.00 for two outlets.
- Dial-out Phone is \$25 per line.
- Dial-in & out phone line is \$50. Long distance and usage fees are additional to the phone costs
- Wired internet service is \$100.00. There is free wireless throughout the hotel.

This year Animelowa is permitting Artists to register for both a table and for the convention membership in one easy payment.
