



## **NEW FOR ANIMEIOWA 2007: COSPLAY BOARDING PASSES!**

Are you planning to watch the Cosplay Masquerade? Do you love to see the great costumes and skits, but hate standing for hours in the waiting line? If so, we have big news that you **NEED** to know!

For Animelowa 2007, we'll be issuing "Cosplay Boarding Passes" prior to the Cosplay. These Boarding Passes should greatly reduce the time standing in line to get good Cosplay seats, and will allow you to enjoy other convention activities right up until we open the doors for Cosplay seating.

How the heck is this going to work? Here's the plan:

1. At 5:00 pm Saturday, we'll open a "Cosplay Ticket Desk" in the alcove area across the hall from the Main Programming doors (Coral Room C). Signs will be posted to help you find the right place.
2. Helpful Cosplay ticket agents will apply a numbered sticker directly to your Convention Badge. Once you have your Boarding Pass sticker, you are free to go to other convention activities until just before 7:00! Yay!
3. When we reach the number of seats available for the Cosplay audience, we will stop providing stickers and close the ticket desk. Anyone without a sticker at that time is on "Standby," and will be seated for Cosplay IF any seats remain after all attendees with stickers are seated.
4. At 7:00 (assuming the Cosplayers are almost ready backstage), we'll seat our Sponsors. (Note that Sponsors do NOT need a Cosplay Boarding Pass! They get up-front center seats automatically!)
5. While our Sponsors are being seated, we'll request that people with Cosplay Boarding Pass numbers 1-50 come forward to our "On Deck" area.
6. Then we'll seat (filling each row) our first group of On Deck attendees. We'll also request that people with numbers 51-100 come up front to take their place On Deck.
7. This will continue until everyone with a Cosplay Boarding Pass sticker on their convention badge is seated. If people with lower Boarding Pass numbers arrive a bit late, they will be seated with the current number group.
8. When everyone with a Boarding Pass has been seated, we'll fill any remaining seats with people on "Standby."

Crazy scheme? Possibly! But we figure, if it works for the airlines, why shouldn't it work for Animelowa! We appreciate everyone's support and patience, and hope this adjustment will make attending the Animelowa 2007 Cosplay Masquerade more fun than ever. See you there!
